The **attached I-20 Checklist for International Students** identifies items required for issuance of your I-20. In particular, we request that you **confirm your intent to enroll by submitting the required \$300 non-refundable tuition deposit to Florida Tech by May 1st for or within 30 days if you have been admitted after April 1st.** You can confirm your intent to enroll through **Panther Pass**, our online admitted student portal. ***Failure to place the \$300 non-refundable tuition deposit before your deadline will result in the rescission of your admission.***

By now, you should have received an email from TechSupport@fit.edu regarding your **TRACKS account**. It was sent to the email address you provided on your application. With your TRACKS account, you will have access to **Panther Pass** (pantherpass.fit.edu) which will guide you through tasks to be completed prior to orientation such as, pay your tuition and housing deposits as well as housing and meal plan registration. Florida Tech requires that all new first-time, full-time students under the age of 21 reside in university residence halls, and participate in a meal plan, for their first two years of attendance. Any required online placement exams are also available through Panther Pass.

All students are required to attend orientation, please visit www.fit.edu/orientation/ for your check-in date. In preparation for your arrival, we will be sending regular email updates to your **TRACKS account email address** xxxx@my.fit.edu, please check it regularly.

Florida Tech has a highly competitive admission process. We know you will rise to the challenge, excelling during your time with us. Your financial documents and passport have been reviewed. We are ready to process your I-20. To request express mailing of your I-20, please visit <https://study.eshipglobal.com/default.asp> or <http://sass-smartship.com/sass-smartship/default.aspx>

The I-20 is used in applying for the F-1 Student Visa. This form verifies to U.S. Immigration that Florida Tech has determined you have sufficient funds to cover the first year of study. **Please be advised that you should be prepared to provide an updated bank statement that is no more than six months old from the date of your appointment.** You must also bring the following items with you to your appointment with the American Embassy or Consular Office:

- your passport;
- the Certificate of Eligibility (I-20 form) that was issued by Florida Tech;
- evidence of good health; and
- payment receipt of the SEVIS I-901 Fee. **This fee must be paid prior to your visa appointment** and you must bring the payment receipt with you to your appointment. Information about this fee can be found online at: www.fmjfee.com.

Florida Tech policy states that you are required to attend for one full semester if you enter the United States on an I-20 from Florida Tech. Florida Tech will not release a student until he/she completes one semester of attendance.

Each year applicants who have distinguished themselves through academic excellence are chosen to receive this award. I hope you are as proud of your achievement as we are to welcome you to the Florida Tech Family.

When you choose to enroll at Florida Tech, these funds will be applied to your account as follows:

	<u>Fall 2018</u>	<u>Spring 2019</u>
Panther Fund Int'l Scholarship	\$5,000	\$5,000

These funds will be renewed annually for up to four years as long as you:

- Enroll in no less than 12 credit hours of coursework per semester
- Maintain a 2.6 cumulative GPA

The total potential value of your Panther Funds over the course of four years is \$40,000.

To accept your Florida Tech Panther Funds and become an Official Panther, you must submit your \$300 non-refundable tuition deposit through pantherpass.fit.edu. Tuition deposits are due May 1 (Fall semester admission), April 1 (Summer semester admission) and December 1 (Spring semester admission).

If you have been admitted after the tuition due date, deposits are due within 30 days of the date on your acceptance letter.
